

**RESOLUTION 2015-7**

**A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS**

**FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016**

A RESOLUTION pursuant to the authority granted by section 6-54-111 of the *Tennessee Code Annotated*, and in accordance with the *Internal Control and Compliance Manual* for Tennessee Municipalities authorizing appropriations for stated nonprofit charitable or nonprofit civic organizations whose services benefit the general welfare of the residents of this municipality.

WHEREAS, Putnam County Imagination Library and UCHRA CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates), are nonprofit charitable or nonprofit civic organizations whose year-round services benefit the general welfare of the residents of this municipality; and

WHEREAS, sections 6-54-111 of *Tennessee Code Annotated* authorizes appropriation of funds for financial aid of such nonprofit charitable or nonprofit civic organizations, and

WHEREAS, the *Internal Control and Compliance Manual for Tennessee Municipalities* Title 5, Chapter 29, specifies the guidelines for each such nonprofit charitable or nonprofit civic organization which is to receive such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Baxter, Tennessee, that:

Section 1. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen may appropriate funds from time to time, in such amounts as is deemed proper for nonprofit charitable or nonprofit civic organizations whose year-round services benefit the general welfare of the residents of this municipality.

Section 2. Such funds are appropriated by the municipality to the organizations as follows:

Putnam County Imagination Library	\$600.00
UCHRA CASA	\$750.00


All such funds shall be used to promote the general welfare of the residents of this municipality.

Section 3. All organizations shall comply with all requirements of section 6-54-111 of Tennessee Code Annotated and Title 5, Chapter 29 of the *Internal Control and Compliance Manual for Tennessee Municipalities*, particularly with regard to submission of an annual report of its business affairs and transactions and the proposed use of the municipal assistance.


